"20th Century Recordings" *Lotos Nile* is Jeff's 12th release and the remastered collection of Black's original demos and bootlegs which created formidable buzz in early '90s Nashville. Produced by Dave Pomeroy and Jeff Black, it was this collection of now-iconic tracks like 'The Carnival Song' and 'That's Just About Right' – which would become a #1 country hit for Blackhawk – that secured Jeff's signing to Arista Records for 1998's Birmingham Road album and launched his career. 20th Century was originally recorded and mixed by Dave Sinko and features such luminaries as Sam Bush, Dave Pomeroy, Pete Wasner and legendary drummer Kenny Malone. "A Walk In The Sun" *Lotos Nile* "An album that is obliquely about hope" is Jeff's 11th release pushed back from the beginning of 2020 due to the Covid shutdown. Produced by Jeff and mixed by two-time Grammy winner Dave Sinko (The Punch Brothers), Black's backing band on Walk In The Sun includes Sam Bush, Jerry Douglas, Dave Roe, Jerry Roe and Kenny Vaughan. His catalogue includes a repertoire of songs cut by artists as diverse as Alison Krauss & Union Station, Waylon Jennings, BlackHawk, Dierks Bentley, Jon Randall, John Oates, Jerry Douglas and Sam Bush. Boston's WUMB listeners voted Jeff Black as one of the top 100 most important Folk artists of the last 25 years. His passionate, soul driven live performances of songs from his vast catalog are not to be missed. Jeff Black is on tour now.
